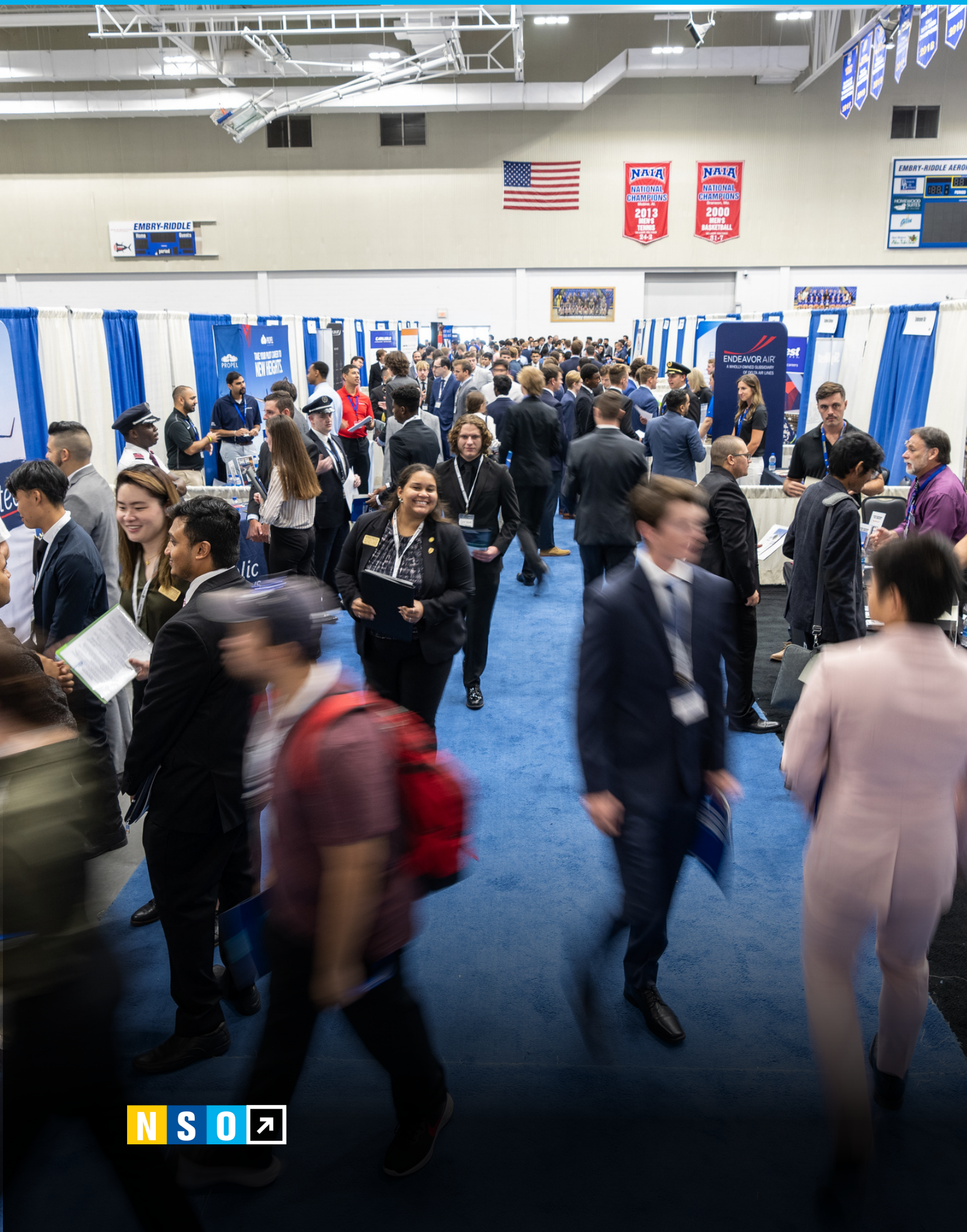

General Services

- Health Services is a full-service primary care center for registered students through walk-in visits or appointments with an upper-level provider.
- There is no out-of-pocket charge for office visits with clinicians for currently enrolled students who have paid their administrative Health Service Fee. We reserve the right to bill your insurance.

Our Team

- Registered Nurses, Registered Medical Assistants, Licensed Practical Nurses, Physician, Nurse Practitioner, Physician Assistant, Registered Licensed Dietitian, and Insurance Specialists.

Medical/Health Portal

- Students can schedule appointments online and electronically submit health forms.

After-Hours Emergencies

- Students should call Campus Safety (386-226-6480) or the Emergency Response Team (386-226-7233). If needed, Campus Safety may arrange for EVAC transport to Halifax Health Medical, which is a Level II Trauma Center.

Health Services Overview

Medical Report Form & Immunization History Form

- Both forms must be completed prior to attending classes. We require proof of **MMR** (two doses) for all students; as well as a Tuberculosis test (within three months of entering the university) for international students from endemic areas.
- Hepatitis B* (three doses) and Meningococcal Meningitis* (one dose) vaccines are highly recommended, but not required. Students can sign the waiver on the form to decline.

Vaccinations Offered

- COVID-19 Bivalent Booster (Pfizer, Moderna); Flu Shots; HPV Prescription; Meningococcal Meningitis; MMR; Tdap; TD.

Health Insurance

- Students are required to carry health insurance that provides coverage in Daytona Beach. Students may use their family's plan or United Health Care Student Resources, which is a Choice Plus Plan providing broad coverage.

"Safe Rides"

- The ERAU Student Government Association pays for free cab transportation for medical needs. Students will need to call/email/walk-in for our Front Office staff to set up the ride.

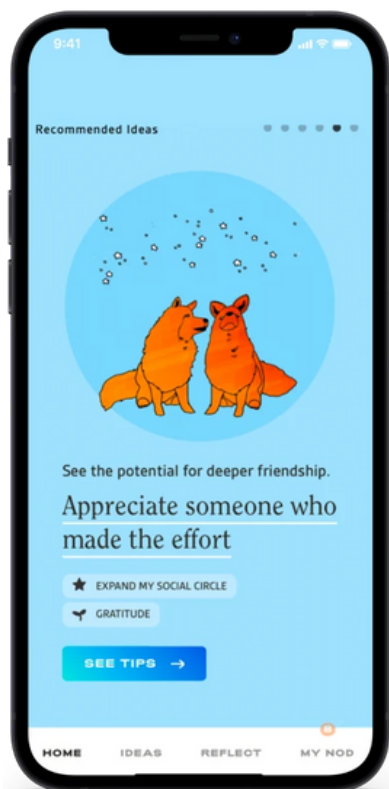

- Confidential/separate from academic records

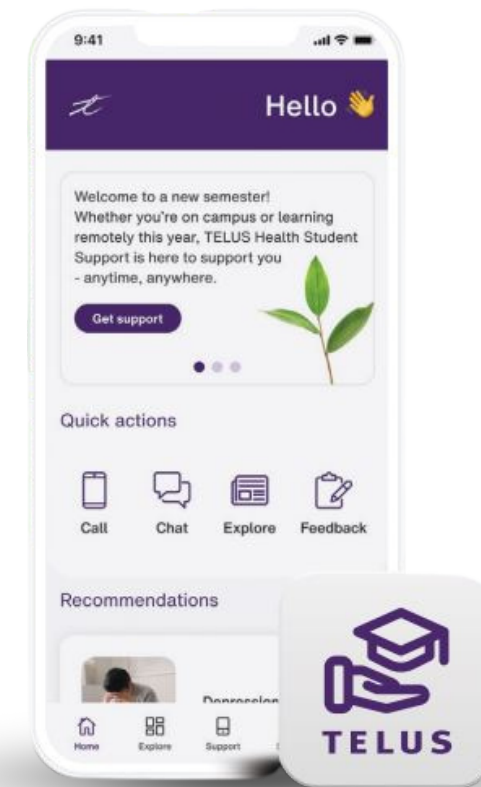

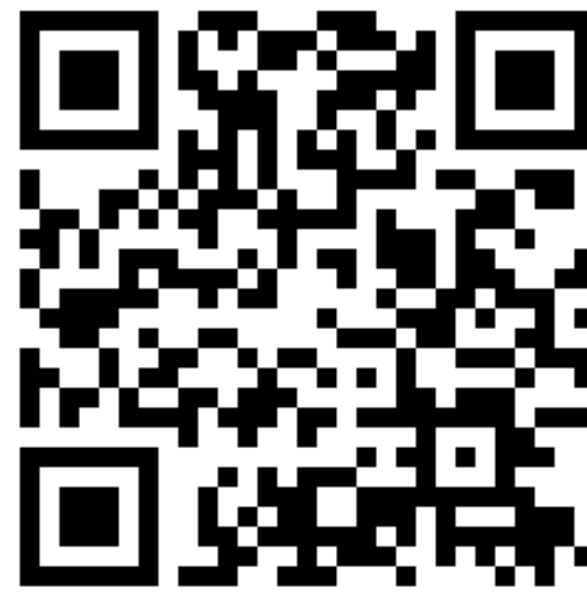
